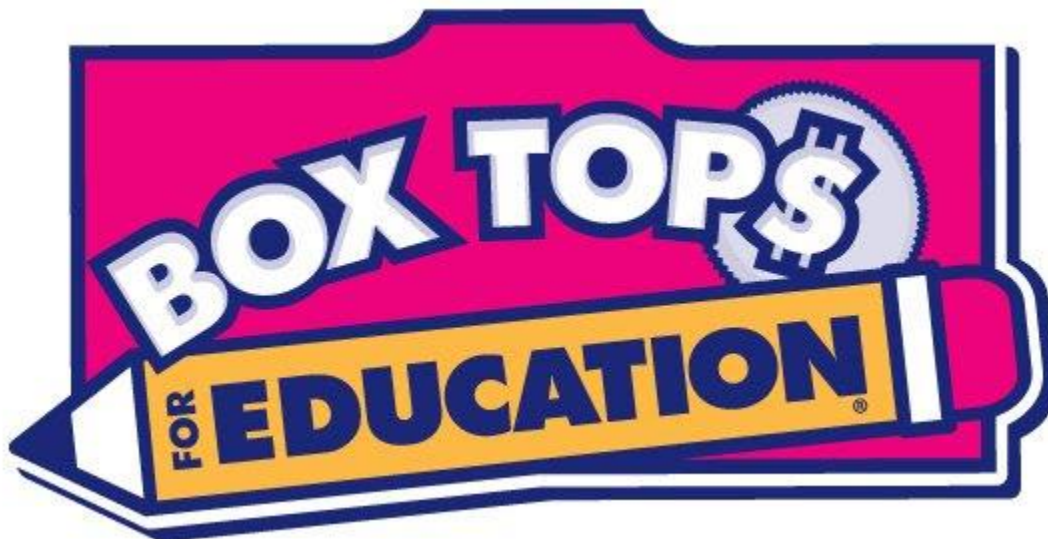
### **Athletic Banquet**


